#### 1. Approval of minutes from the last meeting

The minutes from the last AGM on Tuesday 5th October 2021 were approved by Jennie Spears, Liz Smith and Kate Pearson.

Mr Emissah confirmed that school finances are published on the school performance website: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/school-performance-tables">https://www.gov.uk/school-performance-tables</a>.

#### 2. Chair's report

Helen Fazakerley (HF) started by thanking everyone who has contributed to any PTFA activity; whether that's leading an event/activity or volunteering time – there is a lot of work going on behind the scenes.

She also gave her thanks to the school for helping with the fund-raising activities, and joining in the events where possible, and especially to the caretaker for helping us in the evenings and weekends.

HF explained for newcomers that the PTFA comprises a group of parents/carers who volunteer their time to put on events and coordinate activities which are fun for the kids and raise money for, and in partnership with, the school. She urged everyone to please help if you can, even if it's half an hour of time volunteered on one event.

Having had to reduce in-person events during the pandemic, last year (2021/2022) was a pretty normal year; with the exception that the Christmas fair didn't run and some events had reduced numbers of tickets.

This year (2022/2023) we will run the same events as we did last year, with the development of the Christmas tree sale into more of a festive event. The core team is already at capacity so we won't be adding in more events into the calendar.

#### 3. Treasurer's report inc. outline of pledges

The outgoing Joint Treasurer, Alex Spendley (AS), gave the report (ending August 2022). Many activities exceeded financial expectations, and AS thanked all those involved. The total raised was over £36K, of which over £5K was from donations (including direct debits) and through easyfundraising.

The 'Co-Op CTF' item on the report is the amount of the ringfenced Co-op outdoor learning fund spent last year (there is c. £800 remaining). PTFA expenses included a freezer for ice cream sales and two sum-up machines.

Stand-out activities included:

Christmas trees: £2,926.66

Discos: £3,180.87
Fireworks: £5,280.33
Summer fair: £7,815.91
Tea towels: £2,843.71

The pledges paid last year include:

Enrichment fund: £8K
Book/class library: £9K
Outdoor learning: £10K
Y6 leavers: £1,250

The remaining pledge of £15K still due to be paid is for enhancing outdoor spaces (to make them softer, more natural and more fun). The first part of this project is redeveloping the stage area in the main Grant playground, the plans for which are just being finalized.

We had already confirmed with the school that we have c. £28K ready to pledge for this year. During the meeting HF confirmed a further pledge of £10K for the stage (used for school performances) which is in need of repair.

Jonathan Gunz asked whether we can organize one or two non-uniform days this year, as this could potentially raise £1K. **To be confirmed by the school**.

#### 4. Deputy Head Teacher's message

Mr Emissah expressed how great it was to have the events running again last year, which were even more appreciated following the reduction of in-person activities during the pandemic. He relayed his, Mrs Powe's and all the teachers' appreciation for all the efforts made and energy spent on fund-raising, also stating that the PTFA contributes to the social fabric of the school.

He thanked the PTFA for the outdoor learning pledge in particular, which is a considerable contribution and so much enjoyed by the kids, as well as the investment in books which enables the school's culture of reading and storytelling. So many things have been made possible through the enrichment fund, including visits from/activities with authors, beatboxers, engineers, architects, kung fu practitioners and the Explorer Dome.

Mr Edwards will share at future meetings this year all the enrichment activities the PTFA funds.

#### 6. Independent examiner report

#### 7. PTFA Events for 2022/2023

This side of Christmas:

- 29<sup>th</sup> September: **New parents' drinks**. This was a great success, with c. 80-100 people attending, with a bar and a 2<sup>nd</sup>-hand uniform stall.
- 14<sup>th</sup> October: **Disco for years 2, 4 and 6**. (Other year groups will be in the spring, including the Beginners' Ball for Reception.)
- 5th November: **Fireworks**. Tickets are on sale! Although capacity has been increased on last year, it won't be as large as previous years (which required a lot of marshals). Tickets are being sold to the school community only those outside of the school can attend, but tickets will be delivered to classes.
- 16<sup>th</sup> November: PTFA meeting.
- 24<sup>th</sup> November: Christmas market (an evening event for adults only).
- 10th December: Christmas tree sale with extra festive fun.
